The ELK-319WS is a supervised, wireless window sensor designed to detect the opening of a window or vibrations made by an intruder attempting to break the window. A built-in reed switch monitors window movement and a piezo shock sensor monitors vibrations. This sensor is compatible with Elk's 319MHz Receivers/Panels as well as many other panels that operate on the 319.5MHz frequency.
